October 17, 2010: *The Blind Side*

A homeless African-American youngster from a broken home, Michael Oher, is taken in by the Tuohys, a well-to-do white family who help him fulfill his potential on and off the football field. At the same time, Oher's presence in the Touhys' lives leads them to some insightful self-discoveries of their own.

November 14, 2010: *Julie and Julia*

Julia Child's story of her start in the cooking profession is intertwined with blogger Julie Powell's 2002 challenge to cook all the recipes in Child's first book. These two women learn to cook and find success through the support of sympathetic loving husbands and friends.

December 12, 2010: *Up*

By tying thousands of balloons to his home, 78-year-old Carl Fredricksen sets out to fulfill his lifelong dream to see the wilds of South America. Right after lifting off, however, he learns he isn't alone on his journey, since Russell, a wilderness explorer 70 years his junior, has inadvertently become a stowaway on the trip.

January 9, 2011: *Gran Torino*

Disgruntled Korean War vet Walt Kowalski who holds onto his prejudices despite the changes in his neighborhood and the world around him, sets out to reform his neighbor, a young Hmong teenager, who tried to steal Kowalski's prized possession: his 1972 Gran Torino.

February 13, 2011: *Henry Poole is Here*

A funny, poignant and uplifting story of a disillusioned man who attempts to hide from life in a rundown suburban tract home only to discover he cannot escape the forces of hope and the unexpected wonders of everyday.

March 13, 2011: *The Boy in the Striped Pajamas*

Set during World War II, a story seen through the innocent eyes of Bruno, the eight-year-old son of the commandant at a concentration camp, whose forbidden friendship with a Jewish boy on the other side of the camp fence has startling and unexpected consequences.

April 10, 2011: *Up in the Air*

The odyssey of Ryan Bingham, a corporate downsizer and business traveler who, after years of staying happily airborne, suddenly finds himself ready to make a real connection. Faced with the prospect of being grounded, he begins to contemplate what it might actually mean to have a home.
